

# Coolidge Municipal Airport (P08)

## Parents

Thank you for attending the Coolidge Airport 1<sup>st</sup> Saturday Lion's Pancake Breakfast. To help insure you enjoy the morning, please assist in keeping safe all persons in attendance:

- Pilots of taxiing aircraft are sometimes blinded by the sun or have no forward visibility. A turning propeller is invisible.
- Please supervise children when on the aircraft ramp. Advise children that touching any part of an aircraft surface is dangerous and should have permission of the pilot/owner.
- Propellers can turn unexpectedly, causing serious injury to anyone in the immediate area.
- Exhaust systems retain heat and can cause serious burns if inadvertently touched.
- Do not let the kids wander unattended anywhere near aircraft on the ramp or in the hangar area.
- If you have questions, please ask a ramp attendant for assistance.

## Pilots

Thank you for coming to the airport for breakfast. People of all ages love looking at and admiring your airplane on the Coolidge Airport ramp and to assure the safety of all in attendance:

- On arrival, **if** a airport ramp attendant directs you to a specific parking area, please follow that person to a designated space.
- Be aware of pedestrians on the ramp, especially small children.
- After parking, chock your wheels to prevent aircraft movement.
- As you prepare to start up when leaving, pull your aircraft out into the row. Please don't start up in your parking place.
- Please clear the area around your aircraft prior to turning the prop.
- Please take care not to prop wash other aircraft or persons.
- Taxi slowly to the active runway and watch for pedestrians and especially small children.
